The Automated Regional Justice Information System (ARJIS) is a complex criminal justice enterprise network utilized by 50 local, state and federal agencies in the San Diego region.

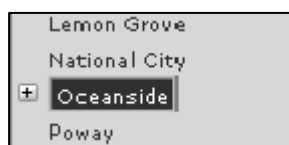
The Crime Mapping section will allow you to look up crime information in San Diego County. There are four (4) easy steps indicated by the buttons on the far left labeled as follows:

- STEP 1. Location**
- STEP 2. Incidents**
- STEP 3. Time Period**
- STEP 4. Map**

Each step must be completed before going on to the next. For example, you will notice that when you complete one step, the button for the next step will change from being grayed out and you will be able to select it.

- Go to **www.arjis.org**
- Click on **Crime MAPS**
- Read the disclaimer and click on **Accept**.
- Click on **Go To Mapping**.

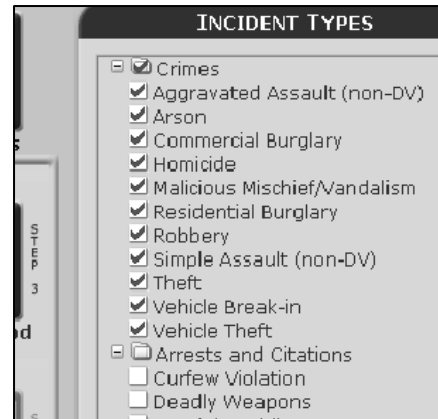
Step 1: In the **Jurisdiction** box, click the plus sign (+) next to **Oceanside** to see the list of all the neighborhoods.



If you don't know the neighborhood name, click on **Oceanside**, then in the center box click **Address** (or **Intersection**) to select the type. For example, click **Address** if you have the specific address. In the box on the right enter the address, then click the **Verify Address** button and select the radius.

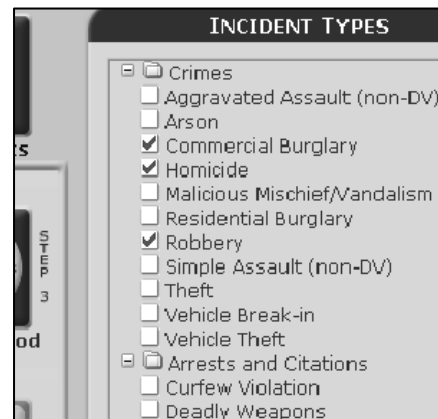
Step 2: The next step is **Incidents** (click on the **Incidents** box).

Click on the **Crimes** folder to select all the crimes:



OR

Click on the individual boxes to select only specific crimes:



Step 3: The next step is **Time Period** (click on the **Time Period** box).

Set the **Start date** and the **End date**:



Note: The date range must be no more than 92 days.

Step 4: The next step is **Map** (click on the **Map** box). The shaded circle will indicate the radius and the icons indicate the different crimes. Click the **Legend** button to the right of the map to see the crime-icon associations.

Click the **Report** button to the right of the map to see the data in report format.

You can change the sort order of the report by clicking the **Sort Options** button. The exact address will not be provided on the report, only the 100 block. To print the report, click the **Print Report** button.
